

## Historical Research Report Project Choice Board Due March 21st

Read the descriptions below and choose *one* project. Every project requires research, and you are required to submit a Works Cited page for the project. The project is graded for *mastery of the standard, creativity/effort, research, and understanding of the main ideas of a modern day witch hunt*. **Remember, the project is based on a Modern Day Witch Hunt, not the Crucible, or McCarthyism. ALL RESEACHRH MUST BE MLA CITED.** *You are responsible for bringing materials you need for your project to homeroom on Wednesday, March 19<sup>th</sup>.*

<p><b>Comic Book</b></p> <p>Draw a comic book that tells the story of a modern day witch hunt. It must be historically accurate, but be a narrative. It must recreate all of the key points and maintain the theme of the original witch hunt. Make sure to include exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution.</p>	<p><b>Newspaper</b></p> <p>Use Microsoft Publisher or similar software, or paper to create a 4 page Newspaper specifically related to your modern day witch hunt. You must include at least 3 “News” articles that you wrote, 2 editorial pieces, 2 advertisements, and a editorial from the editor-in-chief which is persuasive in nature.</p>	<p><b>Spoken Word/Lyrics</b></p> <p>Write a poem or song that speaks out for an unheard person in your modern day witch hunt. Focus on the persons’ emotions and motivations. Use poetic and sound devices to communicate the theme. Perform or record your song to present to the class.</p>
<p><b>Mural Art</b></p> <p>Create a large artistic representation of the major issues of the struggle for power in your modern day witch hunt. You may use any medium you’d like (pencil, paint, chalk, etc). Your mural must be large, at least 3ft by 3ft.</p>	<p><b>Timeline</b></p> <p>Create a timeline that lists all of the events mentioned in modern day witch hunt. Research 5 or more opinion pieces about the modern day witch hunt match them to an event in the play. Include images and other visuals to aid in understanding of the modern day witch hunt and the public’s perception of the witch hunt.</p>	<p><b>Speech</b></p> <p>Write and deliver a persuasive speech using rhetorical devices (ethos, pathos, logos) to education and convince the class to take action against a modern day witch hunt.</p>
